My dear Friends,

Glory to Jesus Christ!

Blessed Sunday to all of you and your loved ones! I trust that my message found everyone well and sound and that you have been enjoying the fall season.

Since today we celebrate in America the **National Clergy Appreciation Day**, I would like to thank **Protodeacon Don** for his service to our Lord and His Holy Church during all of these years and wish him the abundance of our Lord's blessings in his diaconal service. Thank you, Protodeacon Don! We appreciate your service!

The situation in our beloved Ukraine still remains grave. My native land is still under a heavy attack from the side of Russia and whoever else sides with it in this horrible war... So many victims, including innocent children... How much longer will this bloodshed last? Right now, the People of Ukraine are being crucified... in fact, it is Christ Himself Who is being crucified again... Yet, life does not end with death! After the crucifixion and death comes resurrection! The resurrection will come for Ukraine as well! Our risen Lord continues to embrace all people, who grieve due to having lost their loved ones because of the war in Ukraine, asking them to have faith in Him and not be afraid, for one day they will see their loved ones again, as this is a temporary absence. 
