## Glory to Jesus Christ!

Blessed Sunday of the Prodigal Son to all of you and your loved ones! I trust that my message found everyone well and sound and that you have been enjoying the winter.

In addition to commemorating on **January 31<sup>st</sup>** the **Holy Wonderworkers and Unmercenaries Cyrus and John** as well as **St. Athanasia** and her three daughters: **St. Theodotia, St. Theopista, and St. Eudokia**, we'll likewise be commemorating for the first time this year **St. John Bosco** who was approved to be added to our church calendar by our bishops at the 2023 Synod of the Ukrainian Catholic Bishops in Rome.

Let us continue to ***pray and act*** for the end of Russia's war against Ukraine as well as for the conversion of Ukraine's aggressors and, as Ukraine's son, I'd like to tell all of you: **THANK YOU FOR YOUR SUPPORT OF OUR SUFFERING BROTHERS AND SISTERS IN UKRAINE!** Ukraine direly needs our help right now! If you would like to **help financially** your brothers and sisters in Ukraine, please **see a separate notice in the bulletin of how you can help**. No amount is too small, yet please be generous, and I thank you in advance for your munificence! May our Good Lord reward you abundantly for it in this life and in the life to come!

Speaking of Ukraine, since there are currently a lot of debates in this country in regard to whether to continue to provide the much-needed security assistance to Ukraine or not, I **strongly encourage you to contact your elected officials in the United States Congress as soon as possible and firmly** ask them to support Ukraine regarding the security assistance for the country. Since there is no need for you to ask to support Ukraine from the side of the Ohio Senator Sherrod Brown (D), who on the issue of Ukraine is very pro-Ukrainian and to whom I am very grateful for his stance in this important matter (*by the way, this is not a political endorsement on my part of Senator Brown but a statement of fact*), you will find in this bulletin the sample letter to the Ohio Senator JD Vance (R), who appears to be quite anti-Ukrainian (I recently received this sample text, which I slightly edited, from a friend of mine – the text that seems to have originated from Michael Sawkiw, Jr., the Executive Vice President of the Ukrainian Congress Committee of America (UCCA)). **If Senator Vance is your elected official in the U.S. Congress, please feel free to un-staple carefully this letter, put legibly your full name (top and bottom) and address on it, sign it, date it, and mail it to him (his mailing address is in the letter) as soon as possible.** If he is not your elected official, please feel free to use this sample text to contact the Government officials that represent you in the U.S. Congress. I also encourage you to share the sample text with your family and/or friends in and outside of Ohio so that they could likewise contact their elected officials in the U.S. Congress and ask them to support Ukraine with the much-needed security assistance. You may likewise contact your political leaders in the U.S. Congress online by finding your elected officials and the way to contact them through the [www.senate.gov](http://www.senate.gov) and the [www.house.gov](http://www.house.gov) Internet websites. **Thank you very much! Let us make our voices heard in Washington DC loud and clear! Let us never grow weary of supporting our suffering brothers and sisters in Ukraine until we all, our Good Lord willing, emerge victorious soon from this brutal and unjust war and contribute to showing the whole world that the United States stands with the courageous and free Ukraine and not with the murderous and enslaved Russia!**

**NOTE ON HOLY SACRAMENTS OF THE EUCHARIST & RECONCILIATION (CONFESSION)**

Generally, Catholics (and some non-Catholics under certain conditions) receive Holy Communion worthily if they do not have even one mortal sin on his/her soul (one sins mortally when all of the following three conditions are present: grave matter (10 Commandments), full knowledge, and deliberate consent), and, usually, these are people who go to confession more or less frequently; one is permitted to receive Holy Communion with the venial sins on his/her soul. Otherwise, if one receives Holy Communion unworthily, namely with mortal sin(s) on his/her soul and is aware of it, committing it with deliberate consent, one commits another mortal sin. Although, certainly, it is possible to live one's life without committing even one mortal sin for a long time and, hence, have no need for confession for a long time, such people could be considered exceptions. Also, in accordance with the Church Commandments (also known as the Church Precepts), a minimal requirement is for a person to go to confession at least once a year as well as to receive Holy Communion at least during the Easter season: to go to confession provided one committed at least one mortal sin and to receive Holy Communion provided one did not commit even one mortal sin.
